Michael A. Cline, vice president of Venturist, served as a Special Investigations and Counterintelligence Officer in the Air Force Office of Special Investigations from 1973-1996 including tours of duty related to wartime/contingency counterintelligence operations in the UK, Germany, Turkey and HQ AFOSI.

He was the director of wartime counterintelligence for HQ USAFE from 1986-1989. He served on the faculty of the Air Command and Staff College as Director Low-Intensity Conflict curriculum from 1992-93 and Director War and Contingency Planning for HQ AFOSI in 1993-1996.

He is a co-founder and principal instructor of the Prometheus Academy and is the coauthor of *The Guide to Strategic Planning and Execution* (Venturist Publishing, 2008) and author of numerous training presentations related to strategy.

Since 1996, he has instructed hundreds of business executives on the principles of strategy and plays a key role in assembling inputs, analyzing data, and writing resultant Strategic plans.

He has volunteered his research and writing skills to the Wikimedia Foundation since 2007 creating over 500 new Wikipedia articles on a wide variety of geographical, historical and natural history topics. He was the strategy advisor to the Wikimedia Foundation during the establishment of the Wiki Education Program, a national collaboration between academia, students and Wikipedia editors.

In 2014 he was selected as a Wikipedia Visiting Scholar at Montana University where he advises MSU faculty, staff and students on uses of Wikipedia of interest to the university.
